6.3 Methods and materials for containment and cleaning up

Absorb spilled material in dry sand or inert absorbent before recovering it into a covered container. In case of large amount of spillage, contain a spill by bunding. Fire-extinguishing devices should be prepared in case of a fire. Use spark-proof tools and
